


LOCATION

Our 52-acre outpost is surrounded by the Tongass National Forest on Prince of Wales Island's craggy west coast—aka the "salmon super highway." Here, nutrient-rich spring runoff and a confluence of ocean currents create ideal habitat for bait fish, which draw the epic runs of king and silver salmon, halibut, lingcod, and more than 20 other sport fish.







The Last Frontier

Accessible only by air and sea, Waterfall Resort is located in the 1,100-island Alexander Archipelago near Southeast Alaska's famed Inside Passage.

Board your floatplane in Ketchikan, the Alaska port just 90 minutes from Seattle, and enjoy the scenic ride to our dock.


Forested Setting

HISTORY

A CENTURY OF TRADITION

FROM RECORD-BREAKING ALASKA CANNERY TO WORLD-CLASS FISHING LODGE.

The story of Waterfall Resort began in 1912, when commercial fishermen founded Waterfall Cannery near a natural waterfall on Prince of Wales Island. The cannery set a record in seafood production, thriving for over half a century until new ownership transformed it into a full-service lodge. To this day, the fishing here is still phenomenal.

CRITTERS

JAW-DROPPING WILDLIFE

TAKE A FRONT-ROW SEAT TO WILDEST ALASKA, HOME TO BIG FISH, BIG WHALES, BEARS, AND BALD EAGLES.

At Waterfall Resort, not only can anglers count on an abundance of fish, but you can also keep an eye out for orcas, migrating humpback whales, porpoises, sea lions, otters, and more. And on shore, we share our densely wooded acres with black bears, Sitka black-tailed deer, bats, minks, murrelets, puffins, and soaring bald eagles.

- The executive-style suites have TVs, sitting areas, bathrooms with tubs and showers, wet bars, and wraparound decks; (two beds, one bathroom, 618 square feet).
- 4 Tongass Townhouses
 Townhouses have TVs, sitting
 and dressing areas, full kitchens,
 washer/dryers, and fireplaces;
 (two bedrooms, four beds, 2.5
 bathrooms, 853 square feet).
